ENROLLMENT POLICIES 2019-2020

** Registration Policy

Registration for classes commits a student to both Fall and Spring semesters. Each student must submit the following release forms: Medical, Photo Release, Lost & Found, and Liability. The Liability Release Form must be notarized. After May 14th, the registration fee increases to \$20/family. There is also a \$10 student material fee per class per semester for all classes offered.

** Payment Policy

Arts Enrichment & non-high school academic classes are \$8 per hour, \$10 per 1.5 hour class. High school academic classes are \$15 per hour.

Payments will be due in 4-week cycles. A late fee of \$15 will be applied to payments received after the due date. No student will be allowed to register for the new academic year with an unpaid balance from the previous year. For your convenience, statements will be in binders on the front lobby table during the week they are due, and you may leave your payments in the binder or the office.

** Drop or Add Policy

After classes have begun, you will be given 2 weeks to drop or add a class but after that date it is assumed your student will finish the school year in the class.

** Attendance & Continued Payment Policy

Please do not be tardy for classes so as not to disrupt the flow of learning for the class. Once you have enrolled in classes at Peachtree you are responsible for payment of these classes whether your student attends or not. In the case of extended illness or moving away from the Cookeville area, a partial refund will be issued as appropriate with proper notice.

** Snow or Weather Policy

In the case of snow, severe weather or weather warnings, Peachtree consults & considers a number of different resources before canceling classes. It may be a decision consistent with other institutions or may not. Peachtree's decisions will be posted on our website & on our Facebook page. Make ups will be scheduled when possible. If make ups are not scheduled you will not be charged for the cancelled classes.
