Payment Policy:

Group Homeschool Enrichment Classes are \$8 per hour and \$10 per 1.5 hour. An annual registration fee of \$25 per family is required, along with a \$10 material fee per class **each semester**. Junior High & Peachtree Prep classes cost \$10 and \$15 respectively. Tuition is charged in four week blocks, and is due the first week of each block. **A fee of \$15 will be charged for any payments made after the due date.** There is a **three week period** in which you can drop or add a class, but after that date, you will be responsible for the full semester's tuition. You are responsible for payment whether your student attends each class or not. In the case of extended illness or moving away from the Cookeville area, a partial refund will be issued. If a class is cancelled due to inclement weather and a class cannot be rescheduled, you will not be charged for that class.

Peachtree Payment Policy

Payments are DUE the first week of our billing cycle, which is generally every four weeks.

A late fee of \$15 will be applied to payments received after the first week. No student will be allowed to register for the new academic year with an unpaid balance from the previous year. For your convenience, statements will be in binders on the front lobby desk during the week they are due, and you can pay in person at Peachtree or pay electronically on PayPal, with an added \$2 fee.

Enrollment Policies 2021-2022

** Registration Policy

Registration for classes commits a student to a full school year calendar, **August-May** (except as noted in a few one-semester classes). Each student must submit the following release forms: Medical, Photo Release, Lost & Found, and Liability. The Liability Release Form must be notarized. The registration fee is **\$25/family**. Unless otherwise noted (see class descriptions), there is a **\$10 material fee per class per semester** for all classes.

** Payment Policy

-Payments will be due in 4-week cycles, due the **first week** of each cycle, **NOT** per month.

** Drop or Add Policy

After classes have begun, you will be given **3 weeks** to drop or add a class but after that date it is assumed your student will finish the school year in the class. *Once you have passed the drop window of 3 weeks, you are responsible for payment whether your student attends or not.* In the case of extended illness or moving away from the Cookeville area, a partial refund will be issued as appropriate with proper notice.

** Snow or Weather Policy

In the case of snow, severe weather or weather warnings, Peachtree makes our own independent decision to close or not, separate from institutions including the public school systems. Our decision will be emailed and posted on our website as well as our Instagram & Facebook pages as early as possible on the day in question. Make-up classes will be scheduled when possible. If make-up classes are not scheduled you will be refunded for cancelled classes.
